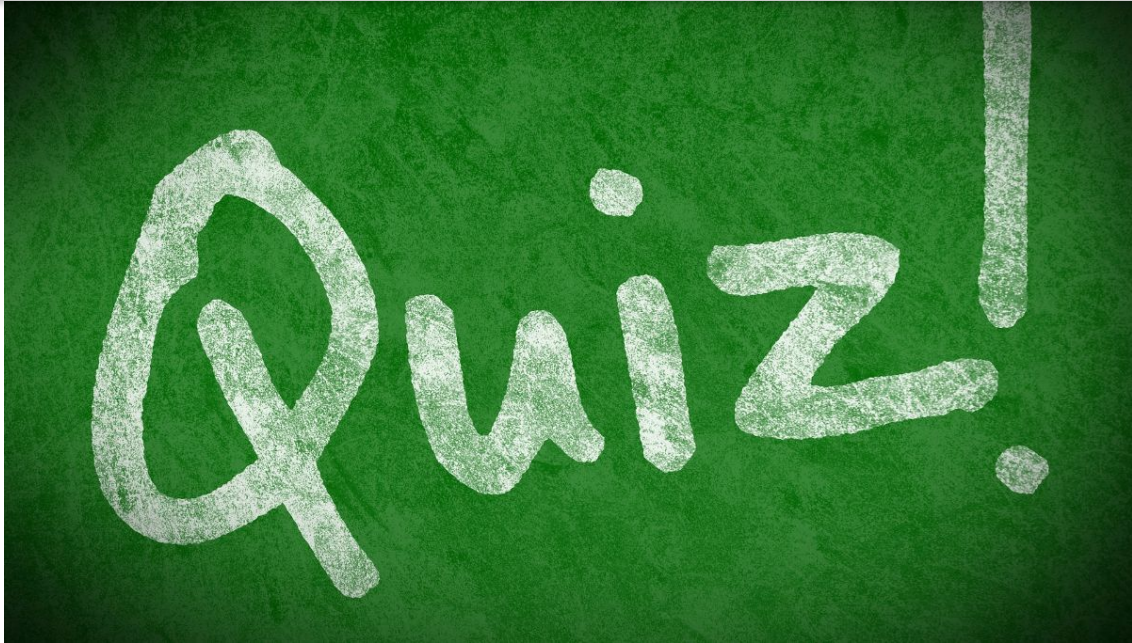
Pupils from Bryntirion Comprehensive School History Club are providing talks
